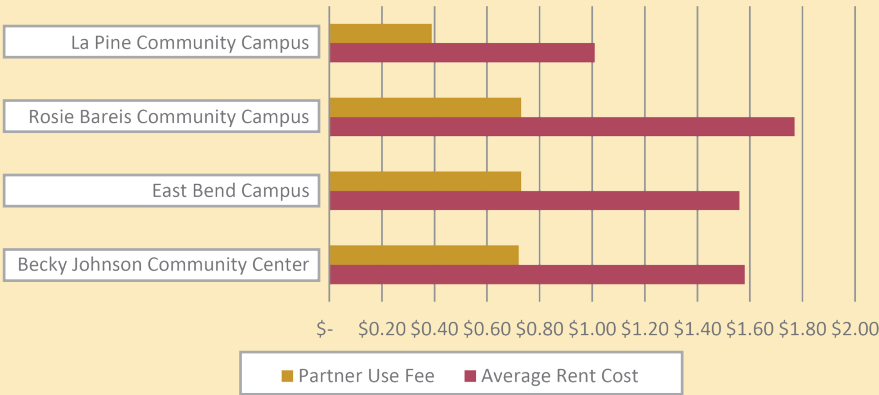
Join us on Saturday, May 4, 2019 for a memorable evening featuring wine and beer tastings, live and silent auctions, and live music in support of children and families.



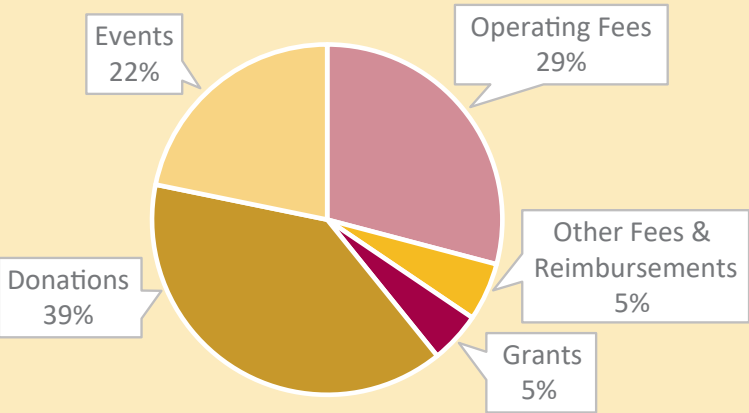
Your Donations Make a Difference

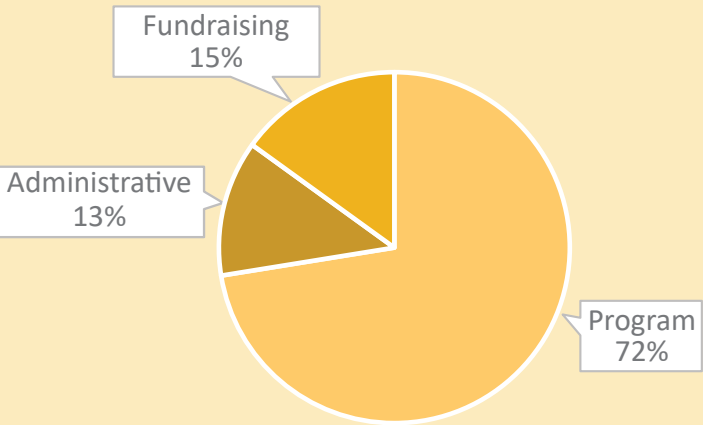
Monthly Rent Comparison per Square Foot
