



STRATEGIC PLAN 2022: The mission of Second Chance Thoroughbreds, Inc. is to provide Off the Track Thoroughbreds (OTTBs) with a soft landing after the end of their racing careers. We are dedicated to rehabilitating, retraining and rehoming of OTTB's. We acquire horses straight from the Finger Lakes Race track, owner surrenders, and local advertisements selling horses for \$500 or less. We provide ample downtime, routine and alternative veterinary care, retraining and transitioning our thoroughbreds to a new career. When ready, our thoroughbreds are available for adoption with a no breeding/no auction contract and right of first refusal. We also work to educate and demonstrate to the public how versatile and trainable thoroughbreds are through riding lessons, summer horsemanship program, clinics, shows, parades, community events, etc. All stallions/colts are gelded upon arrival and all of our mares are adopted with a no breeding contract. We regularly network thoroughbreds needing homes in our area and maintain an active social media presence. We are a 501c3 organization, established in 2012 and accredited by the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance since 2016. We will reapply for accreditation in 2022.

DEVELOPMENT: Second Chance Thoroughbreds, Inc. is funded through a variety of sources including grants, gifts, and donations. We plan on raising over \$5,000 through our two fundraising events, the SCT Jubilee Music Benefit in August and our Thoroughbred Jubilee Horse Show in September. We continuously apply for a variety of grants throughout the year including local opportunities. We strive to be a fiscally responsible organization, and do not take in more horses than we can support with our current funding. We utilize all program and adoption fees to fund the costs associated with the care and retraining of our thoroughbreds and are an all-volunteer organization.

SUCCESSION PLAN: By 2025, Second Chance Thoroughbreds will be adding new board members who can actively help the organization grow and eventually taking over as Executive Director with the original board members staying on in advisory positions. The barn will always be available for the horses of Second Chance Thoroughbreds

either through lease or sale. Maisey Pautz has recently joined the board as secretary, and it is planned in the future she will take over the role of director.
