Anne Arundel County Public Schools has partnered with *HOPE for All* for many years. Through this partnership, AACPS is able to connect families in need to the many resources HOPE for All offers. Individual schools are able to fill out and submit a referral to HOPE for All on behalf of students and families.

From school supplies and clothing, to household goods and bedding, HOPE for All is there to help many of our students and families. The demand for the resources and support provided by HOPE for All continues to increase in our county.

This past year, HOPE for All was able to distribute close to \$190,000.00 of purchased and donated goods to our students and their families. So far this school year, the HOPE for All “Houses into Homes” program has assisted 20 families (86 family members) compared to last year’s 11 families (53 family members). HOPE for All’s “Head to Toe” program, was able to clothe 733 individuals -- 63% of which were children (469) -- during clothing giveaways at Brooklyn Park Middle and Hilltop/Judy Center.
