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#### COMMISSION ON ACCREDITATION ACTION

The American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation reviewed your provisional status for accreditation as a provider of nursing continuing professional development on **November 23, 2020**. The Commission is pleased to inform you that accreditation has been granted for **two** years, from **August 24, 2020 – March 31, 2023**.

Please note: Your accreditation expires **March 31, 2023**, which means your re-accreditation cycle is scheduled for **July 2022**.

#### **Summary of findings:**

Upon review of the progress report submitted for accreditation, evidence demonstrated lack of adherence to ANCC criteria in the follow areas:

- EDP4: The progress report described the process used to identify and resolve all conflicts of interest for all individuals in a position to control educational content. However, the timing of the review of COI forms is being done prior to the advertisement of an activity and it is unclear who is reviewing them. The process for resolution only mentions revising the role of the individual or removal of the individual.

**A progress report addressing the deficiencies will be due by December 31, 2020.**

#### **Required Submission:**

- EDP4: An action plan demonstrating the process used to identify and resolve all conflicts of interest for all individuals in a position to control educational content.
