One of our older girls felt very overwhelmed by the idea of jumping straight onto a horse without having any previous experience doing so. The instructor rushed her and was irritated (both in body language and verbal comments) when the child could not make up her mind about her comfort level. We were told to "get the kids under control" in response to the child and one other not knowing if she should ride. She ended up not riding because of the pressure and stayed behind with another child who felt nervous. The kids who rode were very excited and had a great time, but it was disappointing to see children be left behind and scolded for doing SO.
