



## **DDRC Program Outcomes & Highlights 2022-2023:**

Resource Coordination has successfully enrolled 120 individuals into comprehensive services and another 200 people into other waiver services.

Successfully awarded the Early Intervention Evaluation (EIE) contract as of 7/1/2022, including the onboarding of new staff for those services. We are on pace to provide nearly 1,000 EI Evaluations in our first year in a more coordinated, family friendly model.

Early Intervention and Service Coordination are serving nearly 1,200 children and families a month and in Direct Service we are serving 850 children and families a month, which is an increase of 16% over last year, and continues to increase each month. We have secured an additional \$1million of funding since 6/30/2022 for these services to add new staff, provide compensation increases and make changes in operating expenses.

Nearly 500 individuals and families accessed the Jeffco CFS Unmet Needs Fund and over 700 individuals and families accessed funding through Family Support Services. Received approval of additional Jeffco CFS Unmet Needs funding in the current fiscal year.

Community services has done an incredible job managing through and emerging from the (COVID-19) pandemic for all services that require in-person service delivery.

DDRC has seen growth in our comprehensive Family Caregiver model of 100% and a 20% growth in community integrated employment. Approximately 350 housing vouchers are administered, a 16% growth, in the eight-county metro area DDRC is serving, with an additional 670 new applications received in April 2023.
