II. Prayer Team

- Encourage board members, staff, local representatives, and other interested parties to join in prayer via video conference once per month at a time certain where they can be praising and praying for the part of His Kingdom’s work that God has honored them to partner with Him to do!

III. Evangelism Training Team

- Pray for a leader who has the gift of evangelism.
- Pray that the Lord would identify those whom He has called to staff this ministry.
- Use off-the-shelf tools to train the members of the team the many ways to share their faith without an argument.
- Start locally, then allow the Lord to disperse the Praetorian.

- Continue to recruit leaders and instructors
